### **Text regarding the Award**

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and have a clear educational goal leading to a degree or certificate from a 2 or 4 year college or technical school. Service to school and community as well as a need for financial assistance are given priority consideration. The applicant must also be a graduate of Los Molinos High School.

#### Award

The award consists of \$1000 with money being distributed in one disbursement.

To receive these funds the applicant must show proof, to Los Molinos High School, that they are still enrolled and attending school and maintaining the minimum of a 2.5 grade point average.

Failure to comply with the above requirements will terminate the applicants right to any further funds.

### **Procedure for Application**

The applicant must use the Scholarship Application form available at the Scholarship desk at Los Molinos High School.

All of the following are required materials and must be included in the application packet to be considered for this scholarship.

- 1 A cover sheet that includes the name of the scholarship and the applicant's name.
- 2 The completed application form.
- 3 Student resume or profile.
- 4 A personal statement of educational and career goals, (300 to 500 words).
- 5 Attach a copy of your official transcripts for the previous 7 semesters of school.
- 6 Attach a letter of recommendation from school personnel.
- 7 Attach a letter of recommendation from someone other than school personnel.
- 8 Attach a completed signature page stating that you understand all terms and conditions of the scholarship.

**NOTE:** Students or parents may include a sealed explanation of any special problems or unusual circumstances which make it difficult to contribute towards the student's continuing education.

#### **Award Selection**

The award recipient will be notified to attend the Los Molinos High School Scholarship and Awards program on May 31, 2022 at 6 p.m.

### **Due Date**

Submit the completed application package to the Los Molinos High School Counseling Office on or before April 15th.

Late applications will not be accepted.

### **Scholarship Amount:**

The Allen C. Johnson Memorial Scholarship shall be awarded to one student and shall upon receipt of the initial application and selection by the selection committee, pay \$1000.

#### **Use of the Scholarship:**

The scholarship is to be awarded to a worthy recipient who will pursue a course of study leading to a post secondary degree or certificate from a 4 year college, university, 2 year college, or a commercial or trade school. The school where such studies are to be pursued shall be accredited and/or approved by the State Department of Education in the state which the institution is located.

### Scholarship Eligibility:

To be eligible for this Scholarship, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have demonstrated average or above average academic ability as evidenced by a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better for the last three years of high school, and at least the last year must have been attended at Los Molinos High School.
- 2. Have clearly stated a personal educational goal.
- 3. Have provided two (2) letters of recommendation.
- 4. Have demonstrated a sense of responsibility and self-motivation as evidenced by service to the school or the community.
- 5. Show evidence of need for financial assistance.
- 6. Provide and official school transcript.

#### **Scholarship Application:**

 Scholarship application forms may be secured from the Los Molinos High School Counseling Office. To be considered the applicant must submit the completed package to the Los Molinos High School Counseling Office on or before April 15 of the year of application.

### **Scholarship Committee:**

The scholarship committee shall be composed of the following:

- 1. The President of Chapter 89 of the Special Forces Association or his designee.
- 2. Three or more of the Ladies of Chapter 89 of the Special Forces Association.

Should a member of the scholarship committee be related to any applicant, that member shall be excused from the committee for that year.

All decisions rendered by the committee shall be final.

### **Scholarship Terms and Conditions:**

The scholarship shall be awarded annually in the amount of \$1000.

The award may be used only to defray expenses incidental to the students attendance at a 4 year college/university, or 2 year college or commercial or trade school or a combination there of.

- 1. The applicant named below has received a copy of the above Special Forces Association, Chapter 89 Allen C. Johnson Memorial scholarship rules, and has read these rules and understands his/her obligations and responsibilities.
