- 3. Page #3 Student resume or profile
- 4. Page #4 Personal statement of educational & career goals (300-500 words)
- 5. Page #5 Attach an unofficial copy of your current 7 semester transcripts
- 6. Page #6 Attach one letter of recommendation from a school personnel/staff member
- 7. Page #7 Attach one letter of recommendation from someone <u>not</u> affiliated with the school (i.e. community member/leader, pastor, college prep advisor, Boy/Girl Scout Leader, etc...) (see LMHS Scholarship Book for examples and procedures for requesting letters)
- 8. Not following the above instructions may result in the disqualification of your application.
 - Bulky plastic covers are not necessary; please just staple the application in the left top corner

Award recipient will be notified to attend the Los Molinos High School Scholarship & Award Program on May 31, 2022 at 6 p.m.

DUE DATE:

Submit the completed application to the Los Molinos High School Counseling Office on or before **April 15**.
